## **Caring for Our Beautiful Creation**

Spring is definitely here, and Earth Day is our time to celebrate our "Caring for Creation" activities. Covenant Presbyterian Church has invited our congregation to attend a presentation entitled "How Local Restoration Projects Improve Our Watershed" on **Sunday**, **April 27th, at 11:15 at their church at 40 Ohio Street.** 

Kristi Heuser of Root-Pike Watershed Initiative Network will discuss the state of the Root-Pike basin and tributaries in southeastern Wisconsin. We will learn about local restoration projects, the impact of storm water runoff on water quality, and the important role that native plants play in preserving our freshwater resources and in creating a healthy habitat for pollinators and other wildlife.

Our Nature Preserve at Resurrection is an example of a local restoration project in that we are seeking to expand our Low Grow Native Prairie Oval and to incorporate more native plants around the church. Our Green Team is also working to create a Music Alcove and to provide more seating on the Preserve for people to gather and enjoy. Storm water runoff is also an issue for the future development of a natural area at Resurrection.
